Responsibilities:

- 1. Reports to the board of directors; administer all policies, procedures, and guidelines as established by the board.
- 2. Supervises approximately 8 permanent and 90 seasonal/part-time employees. Duties include ensuring that staff provides excellent customer service, conveying an image that reflects the high standards of the entire property.
- 3. Oversees and maintains the highest standards int eh following aspects of the operation:
 - a. 18-Hole Golf Course, Pro Shop, and Merchandise, Power/Pull carts, Driving Range, Practice Facility, and mini-links
 - b. Recreation area includes Cross-Country Ski Trails, Biathlon Range, Walking Trails, Boat Launch, Discovery Canyon Water Park, and Picnic Area.
 - c. Food and Beverage Services
 - d. Golf Course Maintenance, Summer and Winter Recreation Maintenance
- 4. The GM will work with the Board in developing annual operating and capital budgets by monitoring daily operations and by evaluating year financial information to construct annual and long-term budgets. Will act as coordinator of all department budgets.
- 5. Monitors the Society's Cash Flows.
- 6. Markets and promotes the Property.
- 7. Ensure standard area met or exceeded at all times.
- 8. Act as a liaison between the Society and the City of Red Deer.
- 9. Continue to cultivate a positive and mutually beneficial rewarding relationship in the developments and operation of River Bend Golf & Recreation Area.
- 10. Develop effective partnerships and sponsorships with Community organizations in the development and operation of River Bend Golf Y Recreation Area.
- 11. Coordinate and oversee immediate and long-range planning efforts to meet Community needs for open space, recreation programs, and property development.
- 12. Respond to internal and external customer questions and complaints in relation to operation, research problems and initiate problem resolution.
