AWARD CRITERIA, SELECTION PROCESS AND ELIGIBLE CATEGORIES

NOTE: ONCE A MEMBER WINS NATIONALLY THEY ARE INELIGIBLE TO WIN AGAIN PROVINCIALY IN THE SAME CATEGORY

ASSISTANT PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR – Candidate for Membership

Criteria & Guidelines:

- Demonstrated leader and mentor amongst their peer group.
- Leader and role model as it relates to the promotion and growth of the game of golf.
- Candidates for Membership must be working in a pro shop at a golf course.
- Must be a Candidate for Membership at the start of the year.
- Demonstrated involvement within the Community and Association.
- Strong desire to develop as a Golf Professional through a variety of different channels.

Selection Process:

- Each nominated Member's application is graded by an Awards Sub Committee.
- The Sub Committees for each Award are comprised of past winners of that particular Award.
- The 5 **Nominees** whose application ranks the highest from Members of the sub-committee are presented to the Selection Committee as **Finalists**.
- The Selection Committee is comprised of ten of the past Club Professional of the Year Award recipients.
- The Selection Committee reviews all Award Finalists submits confidential votes based on a point system.
- Awards are presented to the recipients with the most total accumulated points.

Eligible Categories:

All Candidate for Membership in good standing excluding the following: previous PGA of Canada Candidate for Membership of the Year Award winners, PGA of Canada National staff and PGA of Canada Zone staff.
